- When you arrive you will see the Different Journeys staff - they will be wearing clothing with the logo on it.
- When you enter, check in with the Different Journeys staff.
- There are no set activities, you can chat with staff, chat with other carers or sit quietly having a meal.
- One of the Different Journeys staff might approach you and ask if you want to have a 1:1 chat. This is optional - you don't have to if you don't want to.
- A drink and parma are included with entry. The venue will be open and available to purchase other things at your own cost. Cash or Card options are available.
- We hope you find it a safe space for carers.
